### EMERGENCY TELEPHONE NUMBERS

**101** is the non-emergency number for the **Police** :

**105** is for reporting **Power Cuts** and advice during power cuts :

**111** is the **NHS non-emergency** number.

**112** is an emergency number which works the same as **999**. It is Europe wide.

**Defibrillator** : a reminder that the parish defibrillator is mounted on the eastern end of the primary school in Lydbury North. The cabinet is not locked and the defibrillator is freely available if required. It is logged with the Circuit - the national database - and the information is automatically available to the emergency services.
