

minimise waste by encouraging recycling of glass, cans and paper, use of crockery and cutlery instead of disposable items, reducing the amount of printed material and ensure that recycling responsibilities and procedures are clear and understood.

5) Ensure the potential environmental impact of any building and maintenance projects will be assessed and minimised

6) Promote awareness of environmental responsibilities among hall users - eg avoiding use of glitter or sequins at parties

7) Where practicable buy from local suppliers to maximise input to the local community and minimise transport-related carbon emissions

9) Implement a purchasing policy giving preference, as far as practicable, to products and services which cause least harm to the environment.

10) Maintain the grounds, gardens, and buildings of the Village Hall in an environmentally sensitive way, having regard to local wildlife and the preservation of biological diversity.

A copy of this policy will be displayed in the Village Hall and made available on the Village Hall website. All those hiring the Village Hall will be expected to confirm that they are aware of this policy and that their own activities and use of the Hall are in conformity with it.

Progress in implementing this policy will be reviewed at all monthly Trustee meetings and it will be renewed annually, at the AGM, by Lydbury North Village Hall Management Committee.
